DIPLOMA AND GRADUATION CEREMONY APPLICATION

This application is used to establish the eligibility of a WWI, WWII, Korean Conflict, or Vietnam Era veteran for the receipt of a high school diploma from the Cumberland County Schools and the North Carolina State Board of Education.

A diploma may be posthumously applied for by a veteran's next of kin (please notate on application).

Verification of Honorable Discharge is required with this application.

Qualifying Veterans are eligible to participate in a graduation ceremony provided by the partnership between the Cumberland County Schools, the Airborne & Special Operations Museum, the Cumberland County Veteran's Council, and Operation Recognition.

The Cumberland County Schools High School Diplomas for Veterans program recognizes the many educational sacrifices that men and women made while serving their country during times of war. After returning from the front, many veterans were unable to continue their secondary education, thus, making it more difficult to secure civilian jobs typically reserved for high school graduates and above. The High School Diplomas for WWI, WWII, Korean, and Vietnam Veterans program bestows high school diplomas to these men and women.
